Virginia Standards for Administrators

Planning & Assessment

(ISLLC standard 3)

- 1-Employs various processes for gathering, analyzing, and using data for decision making.
- 2-Collaboratively develops and implements a school improvement plan that results in increased student learning.
- 3-Plans, implements, supports, and assesses instructional programs that enhance teaching and student achievement of the Standards of Learning.
- 4-Develops plans for effective allocation of fiscal and other resources.

Instructional Leadership

(ISLLC standard 1)

- 1-Communicates a clear vision of excellence and continuous improvement consistent with the goals of the school division.
- 2-Supervises the alignment, coordination, and delivery of assigned programs and/or curricular areas.
- 3-Selects, inducts, support, evaluates, and retains quality instructional and support personnel.
- 4-Provides staff development programs consistent with program evaluation results and school instructional improvement plans.
- 5-Identifies, analyzes, and resolves problems using effective problem-solving techniques.

Safety & Organizational Management for Learning

(ISLLC standards 2 & 3)

- 1-Maintains effective discipline and fosters a safe and positive environment for students and staff.
- 2-Effectively coordinates the daily operation of the assigned area of responsibility.
- 3-Effectively manages human, material, and financial resources to ensure student learning and to comply with legal mandates.
- 4-Demonstrates effective organizational skills to achieve school, community, and division goals.

Communication & Community Relations

(ISLLC standard 4)

- 1-Promotes effective communication and interpersonal relations with students and staff.
- 2-Promotes effective communication and interpersonal relations with parents and other community members.
- 3-Works collaboratively with staff, families, and community members to secure resources and to support the success of a diverse student population.

Professionalism

(ISLLC standards 5 & 6)
